The Scholarship Selection Committee believes that it has the responsibility to uphold these honored distinctions in making its decisions. Therefore, if any violation of the Student Code of Conduct occurs prior to the close of the school day on June 6, 2017, the scholarship recipient will forfeit his/her scholarship. This includes but is not limited to:**

- 1. Violations involving academic dishonesty, alcohol and other drugs, criminal or civil law which adversely reflects or degrades the dignity and character of the SHS scholarship program.**
- 2. Attending and knowingly remain at a party or gathering of any individuals involving alcohol, controlled substances, tobacco, anabolic-androgenic steroids, other performance enhancing substances, or street drugs even though he/she is not consuming/using alcohol, controlled substances, tobacco, anabolic-androgenic steroids, other performance enhancing substances, or street drugs.**

**A scholarship recipient must adhere to the responsibilities of good character and citizenship. The scholarship committee reserves the right to revoke the scholarship of anyone convicted of a crime. A student whose scholarship is withdrawn shall have due process rights to appeal the decision.**

**B. The scholarship committee reserves the right to revoke a scholarship awarded to any student who meets the criteria for habitual truancy. A student is considered habitually truant if he/she is absent from school without an acceptable excuse for part, or all, of five or more days on which school is held during a school semester.**
